COVID-19 Policy for Entry
Location: Sonoma State University, March 9, 2022

*For the Health and Safety of our Staff and Attendees and in following the rules of the California State University system, we will **be requiring a proof of vaccination for entry**. A Visitor and Guest Wellness Screening will also be required for entry on campus – that can be done at check in to the event.*

Self-attestation to verify a person’s vaccination status will not be accepted.

We are asking that attendees provide proof of full Covid-19 vaccination prior to entering the building. “Fully vaccinated” means the by March 9th, 2022 date you are attending must be:

- at least 14 days after your second dose of an FDA or WHO authorized two dose COVID-19 vaccine (Pfizer or Moderna), or
- at least 14 days after your single dose of an FDA or WHO authorized single dose COVID-19 vaccine (Johnson & Johnson/Janssen).

Guests may present proof of vaccination on paper or a smartphone. For example, California digital records will be accepted.

- COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card (issued by the Department of Health and Human Services Centers for Disease Control & Prevention or WHO Yellow Card¹) which includes name of person vaccinated, type of vaccine provided, and date doses administered); OR
- A photo of a vaccination card as a separate document; OR
- A photo of your vaccine card stored on a phone or electronic device; OR
- Documentation of vaccination from a healthcare provider; OR
- Digital record that includes a QR code that when scanned by a SMART Health Card reader displays to the reader client name, date of birth, vaccine dates and vaccine type; OR
- Documentation of vaccination from other contracted employers who follow these vaccination records guidelines and standards.

Per Order of the Health Officer of the County of Sonoma, C19-25:

Face Covering Requirement: This Order directs that face coverings shall be worn, regardless of vaccination status, over the mouth and nose, in all indoor public settings, venues, gatherings, and workplaces, such as, but not limited to: offices, retail stores, restaurants, bars, theaters, family entertainment centers, conference centers, schools, daycares, and State and local government offices serving the public. If you do not have a face covering, we will provide one to wear prior to entering the facility.

Based on guidance from health authorities, neck gaiters, bandanas and face coverings containing valves, mesh material or holes are not acceptable. Face shields may be considered for members of the public who cannot wear a face covering due to a medical condition or other exemption. Exemptions include:

- Persons who are actively eating and/or drinking.
- Persons who are specifically exempted from wearing face coverings pursuant to other CDPH guidance.

All attendees **MUST wear a mask at all times** when in the building or outside when social distancing cannot be maintained. [Face masks are required](#) inside all campus buildings regardless of vaccination status, except for residential buildings. Face masks are not required outdoors as long as a six-foot physical distance between persons can be maintained. Bandanas and gaiters are not suitable face masks.
